

GULF COAST REGION 2010 SEASON OFFICIALS AND SCOREKEEPING CLINIC PROTOCOL

ALL Junior Players, and Coaches, newcomers and returnees must attend an Official/Scorekeeping Clinic.

Adult Teams must have **two** certified officials & **two** certified scorekeepers on their team that have attended an Official/Scorekeeping Clinic.

ALL players that did not attend a Gulf Coast Region Officials and Scorekeeper Clinic in the 2009 season will be considered a **NEWCOMER**, those that did attend a clinic last season in the Gulf Coast Region are considered a **RETURNER**.

Based on the following clinic time schedule you as a director can instruct and direct your players/coaches/parents to the appropriate clinic session. (Due to the varying clinic starting times the following will be presented in time blocks. Find out the clinics starting time and extrapolate times for your club). Directors during game play assign teams ahead of time, this will save time.

30 minutes prior to starting time registration for all clinic attendees

02:50-04:00	RETURNER	Scorekeeping/R1 & R2 duties/Lineskeeping
02:50-04:10	NEWCOMER	Game Play Court Evaluations - R1&2/Scorekeeping (Wear tops with numbers)
04:10-05:00	RETURNER	Game Play Court Evaluations - R1&2/Scorekeeping (Wear tops with numbers)

CLUB DIRECTORS RESPONSIBILITIES: It is your responsibility to call your assigned Clinicians as well as you partner club or clubs if assigned. After talking to your partner club(s) determine site location, time, total number of Newcomers and Returns you will have at the clinic. Make sure that you have coordinated a time that is friendly with your clinician personal schedule. All directors must provide lunch for the clinicians and motels rooms the night before for those clinicians that are traveling in (since clinicians are assigned in their home area this should not be necessary). Finally all Directors are responsible for providing for their clinic an ample supply of the required forms, pencils and pens, as well as an overhead computer projector in classroom and a gym with at least 2 courts with ref. stands. All participants (Juniors and Adults) **MUST** wear a numbers jersey and be ready to scrimmage. It is the responsibility of each club to reimburse the host club an equal portion of the shared expenses for the clinic i.e., copying, pens and pencils, official's food and lodging, if applicable.
